

## Times Tables - Support at home

Below are a few ideas to help support your child with recalling their times tables. Times table knowledge is a fundamental part of mathematical fluency and recall of these will give your child the confidence to access tricky concepts as they move through their mathematical education.

These activities and ideas are designed to take no longer than 5-10 minutes, and some can be done anywhere!

### **Online**

- Times Table Rock Stars - There are various games your child can access. 'Soundcheck' mimics the Multiplication Check. 'Garage' and 'Studio' allows your child to practise given times tables.

### **At home**

- Group toys and LEGO in to different groups and practise counting up in these. For example, 'Can you make 3 towers of 8 bricks? How many are there altogether?'
- Make your own Times Table 'pair' cards. On one card, write the answer and on another the calculation. Your child can turn them over and find the correct matches.
- Download and play one of the timetable board-style games from our website.

### **Anywhere!**

- Climb the stairs and count in a multiple of your child's choice.
- Sing along to times table songs which can be found on our website.
- Recall times table facts as you are walking or driving anywhere!
